The Rugby Football Union is looking to appoint a rugby coach as part of Sport England's Community Sports Coaches Scheme (CSCS) for the rural Essex area.

### Responsibilities:

- To deliver coaching to young people in local schools and within rural Essex, as directed by the Rugby Development Officer (RDO)
- To introduce leadership skills to young people and provide ongoing support and sustainability by delivering teacher and coach education.
- To take a professional approach in the planning, preparation and organisation of coaching sessions.
- To maintain a comprehensive schedule of coaching as established and administered by the RDO and funding partners.

### Qualifications:

- Must be educated to a minimum of 'GCSE' standard preferably with at least five GCSEs at grade C or above.
  - Will have experience of coaching children and young people.
- Preferred candidates should also hold:
- an RFU coaching qualification (minimum Level 2 or working towards)
  - Current Driving Licence
